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## **Cold River Horse Trail System**

Directions: From Tupper Lake, take Rt. 3 east to Wawbeek Corners, turn south on the Ampersand road, at Stony Creek Ponds, take the left fork to the assembly area. This is the primary access point for the Cold River System Trail - two loops, one 12.7 miles and the other is 32.1 miles long

## **The Santanoni Horse Trail**

Directions: Located just north of the town of Newcomb, between Newcomb Lake, and Moose Pond. The parking lot is located just north of the gate house.

## **The Pharaoh Lake Horse Trail System**

Located in the Pharaoh Lake Wilderness area

## **Sucker Brook Horse Trail**

Directions: From Pottersville travel north on Rt. 9, turn right at a sign for the Word of Life Camp, follow a this road around Schroon Lake for about 4 miles to the Village of Adirondack, at the general store proceed east for .2 miles to a fork in the road, turn left and continue to a "T", turn left, the road ends in a parking lot at the start of the Sucker Brook horse trail. 6 miles of trails.

## **Pharaoh Lake Horse Trail:**

Directions: Take the Adirondack Northway, I-87 to exit 25, turn right onto route NY 8 to Brant Lake, go around the shore of Brant Lake, turn left on Palisades road, the road will veer to the left, two-tenths of a mile beyond this turn, turn right onto the Beaver Pond Rd. travel north 1 mile to an intersection with the Pharaoh Lake Rd. Turn right and travel to the unloading area. 5 miles of trail

## **Saranac Inn Horse Trail System**

Directions: Just west of the Saranac Inn Field Operations Headquarters on Route 30

## **The Meacham Lake Horse Trail System**

Directions: located off Rt. 30, 3.5 miles north of Paul Smiths College, turn right onto a gravel road at the intersection of Rt. 30 and the Slush Pond Rd.; it is about .1 mile to the unloading area.

## **The Lake George Horse Trail System**

Directions: Three parking areas are accessible from either Interstate 87, exit 20, Rt. 4 and 149 in the Village of Fort Ann. From Fort Ann travel west on Rt. 149 continue 5 miles to Buttermilk Falls Rd, north 5.7 miles to the lower Hogtown parking lot and 2.8 more miles to another parking lot. if you continue west on Rt. 149 to Rt. 9L, 7 miles north to Pilot Knob road parking area. 41.25 miles as multiple use foot and horse trails.

### **The Otter Creek Horse Trail**

Directions: Take NY state route 12 to Glenfield, turn east onto Greig Road, continue across the Black River go 2 miles at a "T" with Pine Grove Road turn left. go 1 mile and turn right (east) onto Chases Lake Road. The entrance to the trailhead parking will be approximately 3.4 miles on the right hand side of the road. 65 miles of trails sandy roads and woods trails

### **Brasher Falls Trail System**

New York State Department of Environmental Conservation

Directions: This system may be entered at several different locations. The first location is Meyers Road. off Brasher Center Rd. (County Rd. #53) just north of Brasher Center. Another location is the east end of Meyers Road at County Rt. 55. Another entrance is located at McCarthy Rd. East of Deer River the trail system can be entered via County Rd. 55. 57 miles

### **Whipporwill Corners Trail System**

Located one mile south of the Village of Russell on Whipporwill Corners State Forest. There are several entrances to the trail system. The Plumb Brook Trail can be entered off the Burnell Rd. close to the Edwards-Russell Rd. (County Rd. 24). A parking area is located on the east side of the road. There are several miles of trails suitable for horses

### **Luzerne Campground and Horse Trail System**

Directions: From Lake George Village travel 8 miles southwest on route 9N

Facilities: a barn, corrals with watering troughs, camping sites with fireplaces and tables located in a grove of pine 5 miles of marked trails on State land and an extensive system surrounding private lands Description: hardwoods and white pine. Variety of terrain, flat and easy to climbing to scenic vistas

### **Bear Spring Mountain**

Directions: take Rt 17 to East Branch exit Rt 30 North for 7 miles then left onto East Trout Brook Road. Developed horse camp, toilets, tie stalls, picnic tables and water. 25 miles of trails

Parkway go north to Pleasantville take the 117 exit, left from off ramp, go through 3 Lights, park  
entrance will be on the left. Description: wetlands, woodlands, meadows, fields and a lake. Equestrian  
use by permit only. Multi-use trails

**Schunemunk Mt. Preserve**

Take route 94 to Orrs Mills Rd. turn right and continue to Otterkill Rd. go left. Limited parking park on side  
of road.

From Route 87 (NYS thruway) take left lane at toll booth onto Route 17K. turn right at the end of the  
ramp onto 17K West, travel 5 miles, after passing the Dempsey Pipe Co. on left, turn at the next left onto  
Ridge Rd. Travel the Ridge Road 1 mile to parking lot, Acres: 5,500 Description: woods fields,  
orchards, ponds

### **Walkill Valley Rail Trail**

Trail starts in Kingston Town and travels to Montgomery, NY. Take Albany Post Road Majestic Park in Gardiner there is a street sign on 44/55 (Main Street). Gravel parking area next to the fenced park. Trail starts at the edge of the field.
