The Mud Bug Inn is a boarding stable and horse motel complete with a comfortable, fully contained bunkhouse. For our horse guests we offer 10 12' x 16' stalls. Stallions that are well mannered are welcome to stay with us, too. We have a turn out available that has new, no climb and electric fencing. The cost is \$20.00 per night, including feed which is grass hay. We have two new full court dressage courts, a new pond for swimming horses or for fishing We have a gallop path available for our guests. Our property is protected by a security gate and perimeter fencing.
I am 15 minutes off I-95 on the 378 Turbyville exit. \$20.00 per bed, per horse, per RV, and/or per camper spot per night.

Myrtle Beach is now open for horses on the beach. For our human guests we offer a great bunkhouse and we also offer camping spaces for R.V.s that are self contained.
