Directions: From Bristol via Weaver Pike....Follow Weaver Pike 9.5 miles to stop sign, go left on Hwy. 44, north 4.2 miles through Hickory Tree area. Turn right onto Morrell Creek Rd. for .7 mile then turn left onto Morrell Creek Lane for 1.4 mile. Camp is on the left. From Bristol via Hwy 421....From Bristol, Tennessee's city limits follow 421 south 3 miles to Hwy 44 S. turn right and go 2.1 miles to a 4 way stop, turn right following 44 S. 1.5 miles (you should cross Holston River) to Morrell Creek Rd. Turn left and go .7 miles to Morrell Creek Lane, turn left and go 1.4 mile. Camp is on the left. Facilities: cabins, camping, hook-ups and pens.
