Stay limit 14 days. Season: June 1 - September 15 Fee: \$5/ night

Description: 350,488 acres, remote mountains and steep drainages that empty into the Clarks Fork of the Yellowstone River . Most areas of the wilderness are only accessible by horse or mule, and all trailheads have corrals. This wilderness adjoins Yellowstone National Park . Season: summer
